Being a part of Impact's community means experiencing God's transformative power alongside people living with profound social, economic, and spiritual challenges. We do have a number of specific ways that young people can serve alongside the rest of the Impact family: Discipleship - Participate in a discipleship group and learn the skills of starting and leading your own. Worship Arts - Impact is always seeking to equip and involve musicians and visual artists to lead the community in worship. Kids & Youth - Help share the gospel with the Next Generation by joining our team of dedicated teachers who have a passion for creative education and discipleship. Warming Shelter - Impact is one of only two warming shelters in East Bell County. We serve our friends experiencing homelessness by opening our building as an overnight shelter when the outside temperature nears freezing. Stay overnight, or help by cooking and cleaning. Being part of the Impact family means growing in discipleship and being an active part of serving the immediate and long-term needs of the marginalized in our community. It also means having the opportunity to develop life-changing relationships with wonderful people whose life experiences may be vastly different than your own. Impact is also a church that is sensitive to the complexities of trauma, and our partner organization (Impact Clubhouse, 501c(3)) offers opportunities for peer advocacy training and peer advocacy leadership.
